The meeting was called to order by board President, PJ Azzarella. Also present were Jim Michaels, Bill Lanski, Al Pearson, Ted Schwalbe, Mike Lucas, JoAnne Arnold, Bert Patterson, Debbie Skinner and Michele Bouquin.

Michele gave a brief financial report. The association bank account stood at \$8595.69 as of 4/21/17.

Rosebrook Golf Course will be replacing Hi Tech Services as an association sponsor. A golf fundraiser is being planned for next season at Rosebrook which should net the association approximately \$1000. A 4 person team scramble event should be held this summer. Details to follow. As a side note regarding Lotto fundraisers- Check disbursement will be handled both mid and end month so that winners don't have to wait unnecessarily for payout.

Entries for the city tournament continue to roll in and the team count is up so far. The masters has 30 entries with another week to go. The 2nd Annual Women's Tournament saw an increase from 12 to 21 entries this year.

The board voted and accepted Erick Griewich, Robert Wojcinski and Judy Langworthy. Bill will ensure that all candidates and nominees receive letters. Update: As Judy Langworthy had not yet attained the age of 50 by April 15th, the 4th candidate Todd Langworthy was granted nomination into the HOF.

Miscellaneous- Harrity Optical and Thursday Night Pinsmashers haven't yet submitted year end averages. Michele will attempt to contact the league secretaries again.
