Association Tournament Rules

Tournament Rotation: Hanover Lanes, Lucky Lanes, K & L Lanes

Reservations: Must be paid in full one day before your scheduled bowling date to be guaranteed. Any entry not paid by

that time may be given away on a first come, first serve basis

Shift Prizes: A prize amounting to \$5 per team will be paid to the high team (with handicap) of any league entering the

tournament intact. Also eligible for squad prizes will be any group of at least 8 teams that organize and enter the tournament together. Leagues that are larger than 8 teams will also be eligible for the shift prize

provided at least 8 teams in that league participate on their shift.

1. Open to all members of the Dunkirk Lakeshore Bowling Association.

2. You must be sanctioned in our Association, prior to the beginning of the tournament, to be eligible to compete.

3. Entering average will be the highest average from the 2022-2023 season of at least 21 games. If the bowler does not have an applicable average from the 2022-2023 season, they will use their current season's average of at least 21 games. If at the time of the tournament, the bowler's current average is 10 or more pins higher than their 2022-2023 average, the bowler must use their current average.

4. Any member whose average doesn't meet the requirements of Rule #3 may bowl scratch (220 average).

5. Re-rate rule. Any bowler who has been re-rated in any competition (sanctioned or non-sanctioned) must report this to the Tournament Manager or risk disqualification. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to adjust any average for fairness and will notify the entrant of the adjusted average before their competition begins. Any adjustment will be based on past performance and other pertinent facts.

6. Bowlers must bowl in the order submitted on the entry form.

7. Entrants may bowl an unlimited number of times in any individual event.

a. No more than 3 players may re-enter on the same team, and only 2 PBA members per team

b. Bowlers may participate only once in the doubles event with the same partner, and only 1 PBA member per team. Bowlers participating in additional doubles event must also bowl an additional singles event.

c. Bowlers participating in additional singles event must also bowl an additional doubles event.

- d. Bowlers participating more than once in any event will use their highest score of each event for their all events total
- 8. Entrants are required to enter both doubles and singles events.

9. Champions will be determined on both a scratch and handicap basis.

- 10. All lane assignments will be determined by random draw. A team representative may draw for a lane on a first come, first serve basis until all lanes have been assigned.
- 11. Any player (or team) arriving late shall begin play in the frame and position being bowled. Players will receive zero pins for all frames missed.

12. Handicap will be 100% using a scratch basis of 220, no limit.

13. Winners in both classes (scratch & handicap) will be awarded only the highest cash prize.

14. The Tournament Manager will decide all protests. Protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Manager within 48 hours of your completed shift.

15. Complete prize lists will be posted at all association bowling centers.

16. Both scratch and handicap prizes will be paid in every event listed. All events is a separate prize pool based on the number of entrants. Highest women's score in each event will be recognized at the annual banquet.

17. No tournament prize winnings need to be reported.

18. Replacements in the All Events fund will have to be in writing prior to either entrant bowling their first event.

19. Walk-in additions will be allowed to any shift not filled.

20. Notice of and fee for the All Events category must be paid prior to the bowler's first event of the tournament.
